

Admissions Policy

Admissions decisions are based on the following criteria:

1. Applicants must demonstrate the potential to achieve academic success as determined by the following:
 - Entrance testing
 - Transcripts/grades
 - In the case of pre-kindergarten and kindergarten, required teacher readiness assessment
 - Desire and potential to contribute to the school community

2. Factors to be considered for all applications shall be according to the following guidelines:
 - Applicant's academic strength
 - Current sibling enrollment at Marlboro Academy
 - Applicant of a Marlboro Academy alumnus
 - Multiple applicants from same family
 - Date of completion of the admissions process
 - Date of application
 - Availability of space

Enrollment contracts are issued upon a student's successful completion of the entire admissions process and notification of acceptance. Once the signed contract and a tuition deposit are returned, the student is officially enrolled. A full explanation of the tuition deposit is described in the Tuition and Fees Schedule
