8th Grade Homeroom:

Each student needs to bring:

2 boxes of tissue

1 box of regular sized sandwich bags

Spanish 1 – Please have a three ring binder so that worksheets can be added as needed. I prefer that students NOT use composition books to take notes because I will do periodic note checks and it is easier to have a single sheet of paper. You do NOT need to purchase a Spanish dictionary. I have many in my classroom.

Spanish 2 – Same as above. Plus, each student should have 2 packs of index cards (lined or unlined); a red pen needs to be brought to class daily for editing and checking papers, as well as 5 highlighters (different colors for identifying the parts of speech: green, yellow, pink, orange, and blue.)

Spanish 3 – Same as Spanish 1 and 2 as far as the notebook is concerned. You will be provided with a text book and workbook. You need to have your own copy of the “501 Spanish Verbs” handbook by Christopher Kendris, Ph.D. I personally use the 5th edition, but you may get 6th, 7th, or 8th. I have looked at them all and there have been very few changes. You can find them for as little as \$5 online. You will need 3 packs of index cards and a plastic box for our “verb box.” These cards will be stored in the classroom.
