

"Opt Out of Fundraising" for the 2025-2026 school year!

The Board of Directors has always focused on the major goal of keeping our tuition affordable, and these fundraisers help cover the gap. For those families that choose to participate in all school-wide fundraisers but do not want to sell anything or have to keep up with tickets, we have an easy option for you. Write one check for \$200.00 and you are finished with school-wide fundraising for the year. This will also ensure that your child will be included in all incentives and receive all prizes offered to participating students.

The amount of \$200.00 is based on the minimum goal per student for each fundraiser. Your \$200.00 check will include the following:

- ✓ \$75.00 In the place of participation in wrapping paper sale
- √ \$25.00 Twenty-Five Carnival raffle tickets
- √ \$100.00 Ten BB&B raffle tickets

In order to participate in the "Opt Out of Fundraising" option, your check, made out to Marlboro Academy, must be received by the financial office by September 12, 2025. This option is available per child. You will receive your tickets at the time of each sale. For the raffles, please return the tickets with the name of your choice to your child's homeroom teacher by the dates requested so you will be included in the drawings. You may always request additional tickets from your child's homeroom teacher if you wish to sell more than the minimum goal. Your child will be included in any incentives offered for the wrapping paper sale and BB&B raffle ticket sale which will be offered at the conclusion of the sales.
